The miracle of Hanuka described in the Talmud says that after the occupiers had been driven from the Temple, the Maccabees discovered that almost all of the ritual olive oil had been profaned. They found only a single container that was still sealed by the High Priest, with enough oil to keep the menorah in the Temple lit for a single day. They used this, and miraculously, that oil burned for eight days. This miracle is remembered, and celebrated, eight days in every year beginning from the 25th day of Kislev.

Alephbets used in the text aren't the usual blockprint you are used to see, but converted from hand-written, cursive, Hebrew, as in its simplicity, I find it beautiful.

Size: 35x35 stitches

Fabric and fiber: stitcher's choice (this would look great stitched with gold metallic and white cotton).

NOTE: The design contains over one stitching so this can not be stitched on aida unless the text type is changed.

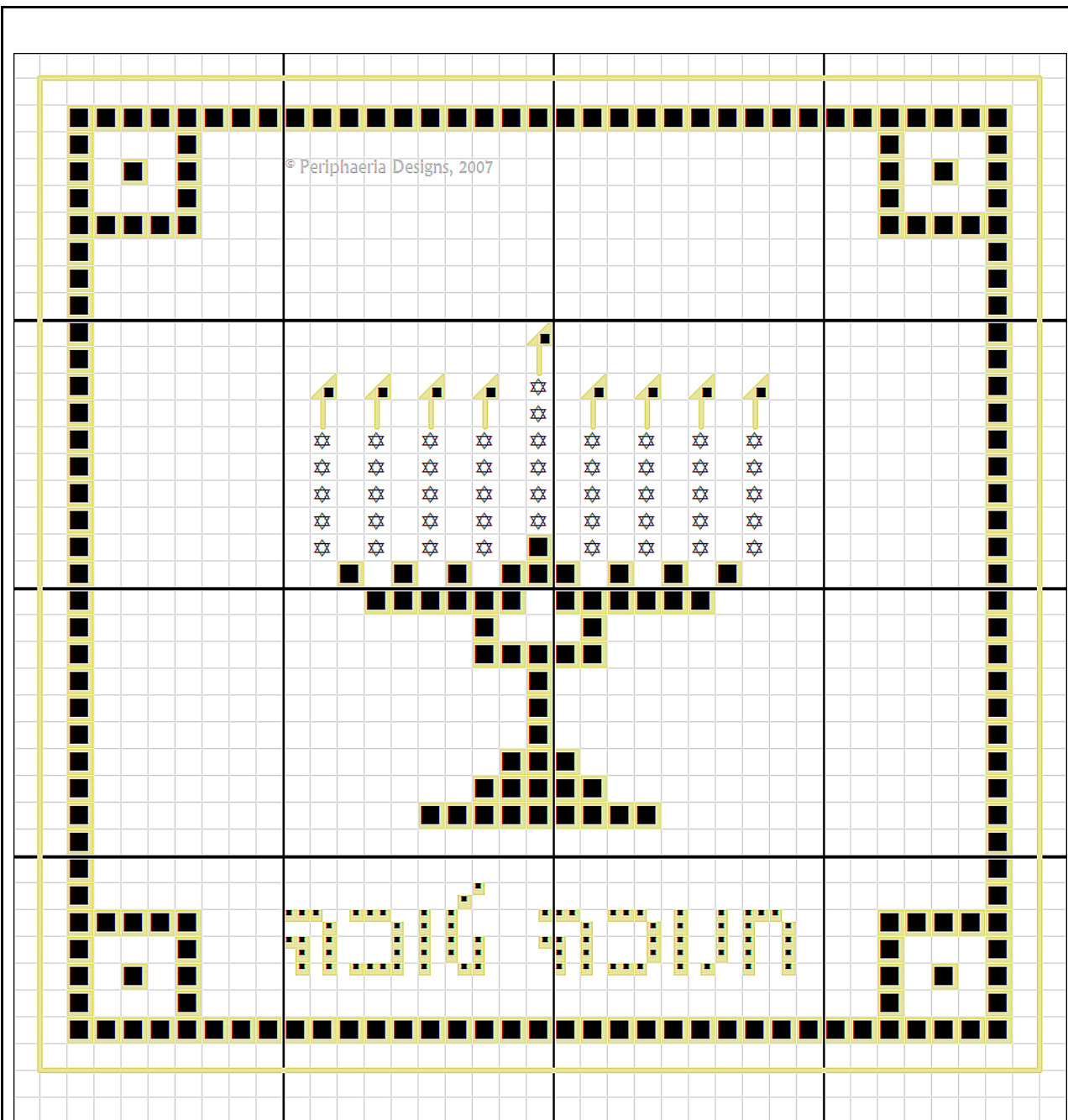

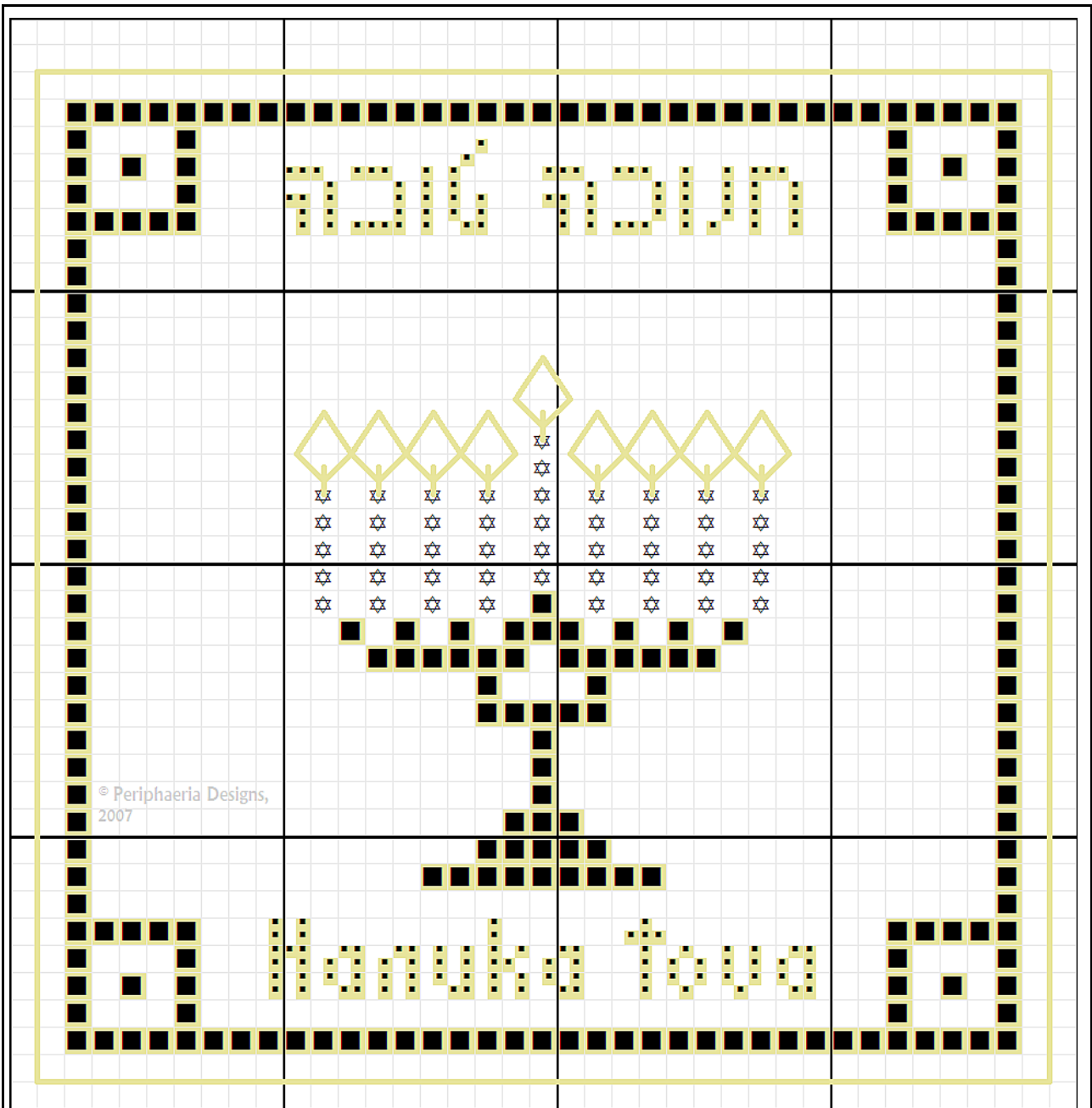
